

## 2022 VSCRC Round 1 Sandown Circuit Access.

### Thursday access

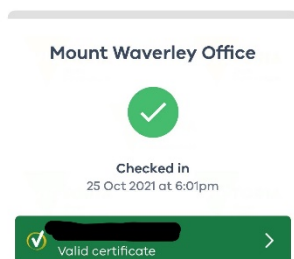
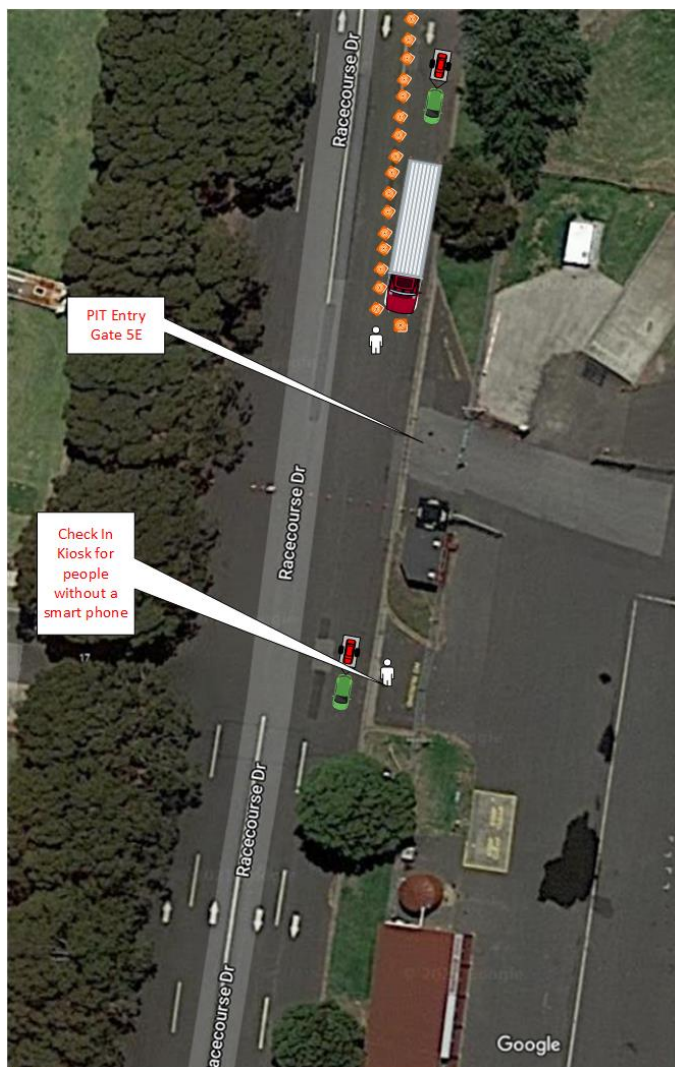
Under government regulations, to participate in this event you will be required to have up to date vaccination or produce a government exemption certificate. Noncompliance of this requirement will mean no access to the paddock or circuit proper.

Access to the Sandown property for the first round of the VSCRC at Sandown will be via the overpass across Princess Highway for Dandenong bound traffic or from the in ramp from Princess Highway for City bound traffic.

As we will be expecting COVID related traffic to be entering the property MRC (Sandown) will provide a luminated sign which will be placed at the junction of the in ramp and the overpass, directing COVID traffic to the right and down to an area past the end of the Grandstand. The road will also be divided using bollards to provide lanes for traffic to follow.

On Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> November all circuit access for set up will be via Gate 5E. All vehicles once in the precinct will be directed down the left side of Racecourse Drive to a check point just prior to gate 5E. At this point you will be asked to scan the Services Victoria QR code using your smart phone and produce proof of your vaccination status. If you have set up a digital vaccination certificate, this should also show when you scan the Services Victoria QR code. Per the diagram. If you have not set up your Services Victoria App to provide proof of vaccination you will be required to produce a printed certificate or other digital certificate on your phone.

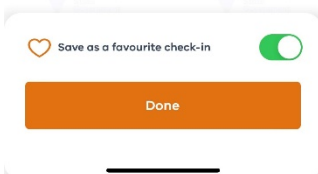
Once the proof of vaccination has been viewed by the check point staff you will be able to proceed to gate 5E and enter the paddock area to unload.



If you do not have a smart device or cannot scan the Services Victoria QR code, you will be directed to proceed past gate 5E and pull up on the left at a kiosk that will be set up for taking your details if there is a problem at the check point. Again, once you have been checked in to Services Victoria and proven your vaccination status you will be directed back to gate 5E to enter the paddock area.

This process will be available for trucks from midday on Thursday and for trailered cars from 13:30hrs.

Once unloaded you will be able to proceed to garage 34 for document validation and to pick up an envelope with your car pass and any further requirements for the weekend.



Please note if you leave the paddock area you may be requested to scan in again.

When entering the circuit precinct and moving along Racecourse Drive to park your trailer or leaving the area at any time over the weekend, please remember that there will be COVID testing and vaccination happening in the area and there could be much more traffic than normal so please observe all speed limits and drive with caution.
