SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. EVENT DESCRIPTION AND AUTHORITY

The Event will be a Multi-Club Circuit Race Event, incorporating the Victorian Superkart Festival, conducted at the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit over a lap distance of 4.45km in an anti-clockwise direction on 7th & 8th November 2020. The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (Motorsport Australia), the Circuit Racing Standing Regulations, the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit Standing Race Regulations (**Issue 05/2018**), these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and instructions issued for the Event.

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Return to Race, OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.motorsport.org.au

Motorsport Australia Permit Number 320/0811/01.

NOTE: This Event is closed to the public, only persons directly associated to the Event will be admitted - Spectators will not be admitted to the venue.

5. ENTRIES

5.1. Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close on 30th October 2020.

5.2. Each Competitor must hold a Motorsport Australia Competition Licence unless they comply with (a) or (b) below. Each Driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Provisional Clubman Circuit competition or;

(a) hold a MotorSport New Zealand competition licence and Tasman Visa valid for the Event; or

(b) hold a minimum of the highest-grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN together with an authorisation issued by that ASN for the Event; each such Driver and Competitor:

- i. shall be ineligible to score points in any Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc. connected with the Event; and
- ii. must receive an authorisation to compete from Motorsport Australia prior to the Event.

5.3. The Organiser confirms that the Circuit to be used for this Event holds the necessary Motorsport Australia National Track licence for each of the Events nominated in these Supplementary Regulations.

5.4. The Entry Fee for Superkarts, VicV8s E30 Racing and 2Ltr Sports sedans shall be as per agreement between Event Organisers and Category/Club Representatives.

5.5. The Entry Fee for Porsche 944 and Circuit Excel shall be \$500 (GST inclusive) for entries received prior to 20th October 2020 & \$575 thereafter until close of entries.

5.6. Entries should be submitted on the Motorsport Australia Event Entry system at www.motorsport.org.au or on the Official Entry Form and emailed to sprint.secretary@piarc.com.au.

5.7. No Payment is required at this time, but will be due 26/10/2020 .Entry Forms must be fully completed in full to be considered for acceptance.

5.8. The Organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning a reason (NCR 83).

6. INVITED COMPETITORS

This Event will consist of races, in accordance with relevant Sporting Regulations, for:

- Victorian Superkart Festival, for Gearbox Superkarts, Non-Gearbox and Stock Honda Superkart.

Races, restricted to members of the following Motorsport Australia clubs, and open to cars complying with club rules for:

- Victorian V8s Inc. (VicV8s)
- E30 Racing – E30 Racing Inc.

Other categories

- Porsche 944
- Circuit Excel
- 2lt Sports Sedan

7.SCRUTINY

- 1.1. Competitors to complete Motorsport Australia Self Scrutiny Declaration and Checklist
- 1.2. Competitors and Drivers Licences will be checked prior to the event electronically using Motorsport Australia competition and event platform.
- 1.3. Vehicle logbooks must be provided by the competitor at the venue to the designated location as outlined in Further Regulations.
- 1.4. All Driver apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

8.AWARDS

- 1.1. The Promotor will make available, to the winner of each race upon request, a Certificate of Achievement. Other organisations may make awards available at their discretion, or as defined in their sporting or club regulations.
- 1.2. There will be no sheep stations, gold plates or large cheques! This Event is racing for the sake of racing, it is all about providing an entry to Motor Racing. Conduct of Competitors is expected to reflect this.

9.GENERAL

- 1.1. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
- 1.2. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59.
- 1.3. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can

be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au .

10.ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
