To be read in conjunction with the 2020 Motorsport Australia Victorian State Circuit Racing Championship Series Regulations,

available from the Organisers.

The Event will be a Victorian State Championship Race Event, conducted at the Winton Motor Raceway in a clockwise direction from the 28th – 29th March 2020, held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, The Circuit Race Standing Regulations, the 2020 Motorsport Australia Victorian State Circuit Racing Championship Series Regulations, the Winton Motor Raceway Standing Race Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions Issued for the Meeting.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Event will be a **State Championship Race Meeting** held over two days. (Friday 27th March 2020 will be a Private Practice activity run by the Benalla Auto Club). The activities will be conducted at Winton Motor Raceway and cars will circulate in a clockwise direction of the 3.0 km National Circuit. (Long Circuit)

Entries will open on publication of these Regulations and close on 20th March 2020.

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

The Entry Fee will be \$415.00 (GST Inc) for entries received up to **Monday 16th March, 2020** and \$445.00 (GST inc.) thereafter up until closing date.

A surcharge of \$120 including GST applies to any entry which nominates for more than one category with the same Driver. In these cases the Driver must indicate on the Entry Form his/hers first and second choice of which category they would like to run. A separate full Entry Fee is payable if the cross entry is for the same vehicle but with a different Driver. A separate full Entry Fee is also payable if a Driver enters more than one category with a different vehicle. Individual Entry Forms must be completed by each car and Driver.

Vehicle classes and eligibility can be found in the 2020 Victorian State Circuit Racing Championships Series Regulations at www.vicstateraceseries.com

All Drivers must be current financial member of a Motorsport Australia affiliated clubs and hold a PCC,PC,CC, NC, ICC or other type of licence as approved for racing Events by Motorsport Australia.

Competition Numbers will be allocated at the Promoters discretion, where possible according to the categories allocated numbers which have been supplied to the series by the Category Representatives. Numbers will otherwise be allocated to best fit with category allocations and Competitors wishes as much as is possible. Only two figure number will be permitted.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the Event in accordance with NCR 59.

Timing will be electronic and each Competitor will require a Dorian Transmitter, fitted in accordance with category provisions and in the left or right foot well of sedan based vehicles.

ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

INVITED CATEGORIES

Formula Ford 1600 & Formula Ford, Improved Production Cars, Formula Vee, Sports Cars(Group 2Bi & 2Bii,2F & (including Invited 2A FIA GT3 & GT4 – as listed in Appendix A of the 2020 VSCRC Regulations, 5th category Sa, Sb, Sc, Group T), Porsche 944 Challenge, Saloon Cars, Circuit Excels, Sports Sedans. MG & Invited British Cars, BMW E30.

FUEL REQUIREMENTS

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

NOISE

Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with the 95 dB noise limit.

TARGETED SCRUTINY

Targeted Scrutiny procedures will apply. **PLEASE NOTE. A photocopy or scan of the vehicle log book showing the last audit and the Events since is required to be submitted with your Entry Form.** Vehicle Logbooks will be checked by Scrutineers to confirm which vehicles are due for audit; and if required, suitable arrangements will be made. Please note that this does not mean your car will not be subject to Scrutiny throughout the weekend. Drivers will be required to present upon request their current CAMS licence, CAMS affiliated car club membership, and vehicle logbook (if issued).

All Driver apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the 2020 Motorsport Australia Manual and is also subject to Targeted Scrutiny.

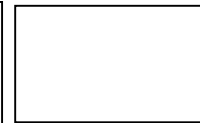

For Competitors

I/We being the Competitors of the vehicle described on this Entry Form wish to enter that vehicle in the above Event/s.

Being legally authorised to enter the car described on this form, I hereby declare that the vehicle and all related equipment and components necessary for participation in this Event shall be presented, at all times and in every respect, in a condition suitable for use in this activity, and that I have caused the vehicle to be inspected according to a maintenance schedule which I have developed and that it is free from mechanical defects, be they of preparation or structural integrity, that may render the vehicle unsafe for the proposed activity. I acknowledge that where any aspect of the car or related equipment and components is found:

- to be in breach of the NCR's and/or the Regulations of the Meeting, or;
- in the opinion of the Chief Scrutineer, to be subject to a serious mechanical defect,

it will render me in breach of NCR 144, and that I may be subject to penalties under the National Competition Rules. My signature below indicates my acceptance of the above declaration.

For Drivers

I, being the named Driver of the vehicle described on this form, hereby declare that I have been fully briefed by the Competitors on all aspects of the operation of the vehicle, including peculiarities relating to its handling and performance during competition; and I have satisfied myself that the vehicle is safe and suitable for the intended competition; and that my competition apparel, including helmet and any HANS® device is in compliance with Sch. D.

My signature below indicates my acceptance of the above declaration.

RISK WARNING AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

Motorsport Activities are inherently dangerous recreational activities and there is significant risk of injury, disability or death. If you do not wish to be exposed to such risks, then you should not participate in the Motorsport Activities.

I acknowledge that the risks associated with attending or participating in Motorsport Activities include but are **NOT LIMITED** to the risk that I may suffer harm as a result of:

- motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property;
- other participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills;
- high levels of noise exposure;
- acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentional or inadvertent) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and
- the failure or unsuitability of facilities (including grand-stands, fences and guard rails) to ensure my safety.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, RELEASE & INDEMNITY

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motorsport Activities, I agree:

- to release Motorsport Australia and the Entities to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
 - my death;
 - any physical or mental injury (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a disease;
 - the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs:
 - that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community; or
 - that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community,

howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Motorsport Activities;

- to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified Motorsport Australia and the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motorsport Activities at my own risk.

I understand that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct of Motorsport Australia and the Entities as the supplier of the Motorsport Activities and Recreational Services;
- nothing in this document prevents Motorsport Australia and the Entities from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability;
- nothing in this document excludes any term or guarantee which under statute cannot be excluded, however the liability of Motorsport Australia and the Entities is limited to the minimum liability allowable by law;
- nothing in this document precludes me from making a claim under a Motorsport Australia insurance policy where I am expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy; and
- Motorsport Australia has arranged for limited personal injury insurance coverage which may provide me with some protection for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motorsport Activities. I acknowledge and accept that the insurance taken out by Motorsport Australia may not provide me with full indemnity for loss, damage or injury that I may suffer during my participation in the Motorsport Activities, and that I may have to pay the excess if a Claim is made under an insurance policy on my behalf. I agree that my own insurance arrangements are ultimately my responsibility and I will arrange any additional coverage at my expense after taking into account Motorsport Australia's insurance arrangements, this document and my own circumstances.

Where Motorsport Activities are held in the following jurisdictions, I acknowledge that I have also read and accept the following warnings:

Under the Australian Government Consumer Law (which is part of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Commonwealth)), several guarantees are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. You agree that the application of all or any of the provisions of Subdivision B of Division 1 of Part 3-2 of the Australian Consumer Law (i.e. guarantees relating to the supply of services), the exercise of rights conferred by those provisions, and an liability of Motorsport Australia and the Entities for a failure to comply with any such guarantees, are excluded. However, such exclusion is limited to liability for:

If you sign this form, you will be agreeing to exclude, restrict or modify the supplier's liability with the result that compensation may not be payable if you or the third party consumer suffer personal injury.

Important:

You do not have to agree to exclude, restrict or modify your rights by signing this form. The supplier may refuse to provide you with the services if you do not agree to exclude, restrict or modify your rights by signing this form. Even if you sign this form, you may still have further legal rights against the supplier. A child under the age of 18 cannot legally agree to exclude, restrict or modify his or her rights. - "Entities" means event and competition organisers/promoters/managers, land and track owners/managers/administrators/lessees, Motorsport Australia affiliated clubs, state and territory governments and insureds listed in Motorsport Australia's public/product/professional indemnity insurance policies and each of their related bodies corporate (including their related bodies corporate) and each of their organs and agencies, officers/president/directors/executives, employees, servants, agents, partners, providers, members, competitors, drivers, co-drivers, navigators, officials, crew members, pit crew, delegates, licence holders, representatives, commissions, committees, advisers, trustees, councils, panels, shareholders, volunteers, officials, appointees, delegated bodies and sponsors;
- "Motorsport Activities" means any motorsport activities or Recreational Services which are permitted or approved which Motorsport Australia regulates or administers or otherwise are under the responsibility / control of Motorsport Australia;
- "Motorsport Australia" means the Confederation of Australia Motor Sport Ltd. trading as Motorsport Australia;
- "Reckless Conduct" means conduct where the supplier of the recreational services is aware, or should reasonably have been aware, of a significant risk that the conduct could result in personal injury to another person and engages in the conduct despite the risk and without adequate justification;
- "Recreational Services" means (unless otherwise defined in this document) services that consist of participation in:
 - a sporting activity; or
 - a similar leisure time pursuit or any other activity that:
 - involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and
 - is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.

DECLARATION

I accept the conditions of, and acknowledge the risks arising from, attending or participating in the Motor Sport Activities being provided by Motorsport Australia and the Entities. I agree to comply with all policies, rules, regulations and directions of Motorsport Australia and the Entities in relation to this event.
